

Criteria for evaluation of the Best Paper Award

Marks calculated from the Reviewer form after averaging the marks of all reviewers = 60%

Marks obtained at the Presentation given by the judging panel = 40%

Review Criteria (60%)

1. Relevance of the paper to the scope of the conference
2. Title of the paper is informative and representative of its content.
3. Clarity of objectives of the research on the paper
4. Comprehensiveness of literature review/background study.
5. Technical comprehensiveness of the methodology of research
6. Validity: The study is well designed and executed
7. Data are reported, analysed, and interpreted correctly
8. Clarity of the paper: Ideas expressed clearly, concisely and logically.
9. Compliance: All ethical and publication requirements are met
10. Comprehensiveness of analysis of results
11. Advancement: Is this a significant contribution to the field?
12. Novelty: Is this original material distinct from previous publications ?

Evaluation criteria for the presentation

1. Clarity of the presentation
2. Technical depth – How well did the presenter explained technical aspects of the research?
3. Visual aids & structure/Quality of the slides
4. Engagement and communication with the audience
5. Handling of the Question & Answer session
